



PI-VET: Powering the Innovation of VET (PI-VET)

What has been done until now

On the 18th of May 2022, the projects consortium, successfully launched an online fair which hosted many professionals from the VET sector, who shared their expertise and best practices on VET education, concentrating on the themes of: Inclusion, Green practices, Digital practices, and Supportive ecosystems. The Online Knowledge Fair was followed by a survey, addressed both to the people who participated in the Fair, as well as to other professionals in the field. The results of the survey have been used to create the methodology which is finally out and available for people to read and download. The methodology will be the foundation which will allow the rest of the projects results to be developed.

Meanwhile, CSI has created the social media pages (Facebook and Instagram) as well as the projects website. These are regularly updated by the partners with news and relevant information which can be accessed by the public.

Transnational Partner Meetings

Partners have met face to face twice until now. The first meeting was in Bulgaria between the 12th – 13th of April 2022 and the 2nd meeting was in Ireland between the 27th – 28th of July 2022. Apart from the face-to-face meetings the consortium has met online several times since the beginning of the project for coordination purposes. In all of the meetings, partners discussed the overall progress of the project and the next steps to be followed, making sure everything is up to date and that the project's objectives are being met to the desirable quality. Next Transnational Partner Meeting will be held in Italy on March 2023.

Next steps

- Development of the implementation guidelines for the formation of the Sustainable Learning Canvases.
- Development of Five Online Co- Creation Labs.
- Open call for participants followed by a presentation webinar.
- Implementation of the Online Co- Creation Labs with 30 participants per theme.
